We ask that our values and principles be disseminated and shared by all our counterparts by disseminating the Corporate Policy and requesting acceptance of the same.

The identification of risks related to the supply chain involves the use of a specific questionnaire sent to our suppliers according to the risk indicators referred to in the supplement to the OECD guidelines “Due Diligence Guidance for Responsible Supply Chains of Minerals from Cahra” integrated with additional requirements regarding compliance with Human Rights, Health and Safety regulations in the workplace and compliance with environmental regulations.

All our transactions are carried out only and exclusively if the level of risk assessed for the counterparty in question is acceptable. Due to the nature of our business, risky transactions are not conceivable.
